### Guide on Travelers from Kirakira

#### Pre-departure

- i. All travelers with the exception of those below 12 years old must show evidence of vaccination by the show of a vaccination card. This is a national mandatory requirement.
- ii. Travelers will need to test negative for COVID19 on RAT-PCR Genxpert within 12 hours to 24 hours before departure time. All negative test results will be forwarded to PHEOC.
- iii. All Solomon Islands maritime and civil aviation regulation related to COVID19 pre-departure protocol must be observed and report send to PDOC for approval of the trip
- iv. PDOC exemption is mandatory for all traveling out from Kirakira to Honiara
- v. All traveling passengers must have their own PPE. – Personal Protective Equipment, like mask, hand sanitizer etc.

#### Departure

- i. Present certificates of vaccination at points of departure or upon request
- ii. Present testing certificate of RAT test or PCR Genxpert at points of departure or upon request.
- iii. All travelling individuals must be sober on day of travel
- iv. All travelling individuals will wear face masks in departure terminal/Kirakira and through the trips
- v. Keeps the protocol of travelling on boat/aircraft social distancing
- vi. All maritime and civil aviation regulation related to COVID19 travel protocol must be observed.
- vii. All individuals are required to have a hand sanitizer or soap and water for sanitizing.
